Regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Sparta was held January 13, 2015 at 7:00 PM.

Members present: Supervisor Mark Schuster, Deputy Supervisor Glenn Kreiley, Council Len Davis, Deb Halpenny and Bill Smith.

Minutes of the December 9th, 2014 meeting were read. A motion was made by Deb Halpenny and seconded by Bill Smith to accept the minutes. All voted yes. Carried.

Minutes of the December 29, 2014 meeting were read. A motion was made by Bill Smith and seconded by Deb Halpenny to accept the minutes as amended. All voted yes. Carried.

Public hearing for the Dansville Ambulance Contract was opened at 7:15 PM.

Assessor Holley Smalt reviewed her report.

Code Enforcement Officer Shawn Grasby reviewed his report.

A motion was made by Deb Halpenny and seconded by Glenn Kreiley to hold a public hearing on Local Law No. 1-2015 (a Local Law amending Local Law No. 2-1991 regulating junk yards and storage of junk in the Town of Sparta) on February 10, 2015 at 7:15 PM. All voted yes. Carried.

A motion was made by Deb Halpenny and seconded by Glenn Kreiley to accept a donation of \$3,000.00 from a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation and donate it to the Sparta Volunteer Fire Department to be used for education scholarships. All voted yes. Carried.

A motion was made by Glenn Kreiley and seconded by Deb Halpenny to extend the Inter-municipal Agreement between the County and all Towns in Livingston County covering the use of County owned machinery, tools or equipment by other municipalities. All voted yes. Carried.

Public hearing was closed.

A motion was made by Bill Smith and seconded by Glenn Kreiley to sign the 2015 Ambulance Contract with the Village of Dansville. All voted yes. Carried.

General bills 1-24 were audited and approved for a total amount of \$27,813.48.
Highway bills 1-13 were audited and approved for a total amount of \$6,473.07.

A motion was made by Len Davis and seconded by Bill Smith to adjourn the meeting. All voted yes. Carried.
