Regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Sparta was held October 11, 2022 at 7:00 PM.

Members present: Supervisor Mark Schuster, Deputy Supervisor Deb Halpenny, Mary Ellyn Calabrese and Bill Smith.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. A motion was made by Deb Halpenny and seconded by Mary Ellyn Calabrese to approve the minutes as read. All voted yes. Carried.

Assessor Holley Smalt reviewed her report.

Highway Superintendent Kevin Robinson reviewed his report.

A motion was made by Bill Smith and seconded by Mary Ellyn Calabrese to accept the Preliminary Budget as presented and publish it in the Town's official newspaper to advertise a public hearing on the matter for November 8th, 2022 at 7:05 PM. All voted yes. Carried.

A motion was made by Mary Ellyn Calabrese and seconded by Deb Halpenny to post Story Road from Liberty Pole Road to Swartz Road "Seasonal Use Only" from November 1, 2022 through April 1, 2023. The road will be plowed by the Highway Department until December 24, 2022. All voted yes. Carried.

General bills were audited and approved for a total amount of \$5,605.10.
Highway bills were audited and approved for a total amount of \$45,360.41.
Street light bills were audited and approved for a total amount of \$187.30.

A motion was made by Bill Smith and seconded by Mary Ellyn Calabrese to adjourn the meeting. All voted yes. Carried.
